



Estimated Impact of CY 2024 MFS Final Rule and Temporary Conversion Factor Legislation on Select High-Volume Services

Note: The temporary 2.5% Medicare Conversion Factor (CF) increase for CY 2023 was replaced by a lower temporary 1.25% increase for January 1-March 8, 2024, as per the *Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023*, resulting in a CF for \$32.7442. The *Consolidated Appropriation Act, 2024* subsequently increased the Medicare CF to \$33.2875 for March 9-December 31, 2024.
