



ARTrust™ Mini Grants

Allergy, Asthma and Immunology Education and Research Trust

The ARTrust™ invites AAAAI members to apply for mini-grants for projects that advance the knowledge and/or treatment of allergy, asthma and immunology for:

- Small clinical or research projects
- New (not ongoing) educational initiatives for professional and public audiences
- Other research including equipment needs, supplemental funding and FIT projects

The mini-grants are available for any amount up to a maximum of \$15,000 for one year. The grants will not provide indirect costs, and the salary and benefits for the project Principal Investigator.

Eligibility

- Applicants must be a member in good standing of the AAAAI at the time of application and a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
- Applicants with a membership status of Fellow, Member, or In-training must be ABAI certified or ABAI eligible.
- Applicants with a membership status of Allied Health are eligible to apply.
- Individuals and institutions that are currently receiving an ARTrust™ (ERT/ART) grant are ineligible.

Process

One page demographic and CV, and a 1-2 page proposal, not including the budget, should include the following elements:

1. Hypothesis (if applicable)
2. Rational
3. Methods
4. Expected outcome
5. Budget

(Proposals longer than 2 pages will be considered ineligible.)

The application deadline is November 15, 2011. Award applications are submitted online at www.aaaai.org. For instructions, please access the Grants and Awards page in the Professional Education & Training section. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

Selection

The following schedule is used in the grant evaluation process:

Submission Deadline:	November 15, 2011 Absolute
Announcement of Awards to Applicants:	February 1, 2012
Award Payment to Recipients:	July 1, 2012

Terms

Payments will be made in July. A final progress report is due before the 2013 AAAAI Annual Meeting. The award recipient will participate in public relations activities surrounding the ARTrust™ Mini Grant, including but not limited to being featured in various publications and public appearances. The award recipient will also credit the ARTrust™ for funding this project when appropriate.
