



2005 AAAAI Sepracor Research Excellence Awards

The AAAAI is pleased to announce the 2005 AAAAI Sepracor Research Excellence Awards.

This program provides \$5,000 awards for each of the three best abstracts submitted by a trainee and accepted for presentation at the 61st AAAAI Annual Meeting in San Antonio, March 18 to March 22, 2005. Award selection will be made by the Abstract Review Committee.

Awards are to be used for pursuit of scholarly activities of the recipient at their parent institution.

Applicants must meet all the following criteria:

1. The abstract first author is an allergy and immunology trainee (pre or post-doctoral);
2. The trainee has conducted the vast majority of the abstract related work;
3. An abstract co-author is a member of the AAAAI;
4. The research is investigator led and is not sponsored by any for-profit entity; and
5. The abstract submitted by mail must be received by online submission site by September 17, 2004. Application process completed

Abstracts will be judged by the novelty of their research development and the overall significance of their research toward the advancement of allergy, asthma and immunology and optimal patient care.
