STATUS WORTH ACHIEVING

Fellowship status in the American Academy of Allergy, Asthma & Immunology (AAAAI) recognizes members' professional achievements in the allergy/immunology specialty and provides a number of benefits available only to Fellows.

If you have been an AAAAI full member in good standing for three consecutive years, you are eligible to apply for Fellowship. Fellowship applications are accepted year-round.

Dues are identical for Fellows and members, as well as international Fellows and members.

Benefits of Fellowship include all those of membership as well as:

- 🔥 Involvement in the democratic process: AAAAI Fellows can vote, propose motions and hold office on the Board of Directors
- 🔥 Professional development: you may list your fellowship status on business correspondence and promotional items for your practice. This recognition as a leader in the specialty's premier allergy/immunology society reflects positively on your achievements
- 🔥 Annual Meeting: AAAAI Fellows receive Annual Meeting registration information in advance of other AAAAI members, and have the first opportunity to register for seminars, workshops and courses
- 🔥 Discounts on AAAAI purchases: 10% discount on educational materials is available for Fellows

APPLYING IS AS SIMPLE AS 1, 2, 3

1. Application

- * No application fee is required for individuals who are presently members of international members
- * Applications may be submitted via print or online application

2. C.V. and Board Certificates

- * Be sure to include the following in your C.V.:
 - Date & location of License
 - AAAAI and other allergy/immunology meetings attended in the past 3 years
 - Current teaching responsibilities
 - CME course taught, conferences given, or evidence of providing continuing education in topics of allergy/immunology or public education
 - Description of research interest and list of publications
 - Current AAAAI committee memberships
- * Be sure to submit copies of your Board certificates, including those related to allergy/immunology

3. Sponsorship

- * Applicants need letters of recommendation from three sponsors.
- * Applicants are responsible for requesting sponsor letters and making sure they are sent to the executive office either directly from the sponsor or from the applicant.
- * Both the Chief and second sponsor must be current Fellows of the AAAAI.
- * The third sponsor must be either the applicant's Training Program Director or current Chief of Staff.
- * Only one sponsor may be associated with the applicant's current practice.

Annual Dues

- * Annual dues for each Fellowship category are as follows:
 - Fellowship.....\$415
 - International Fellowship.....\$311
- * Each year \$52 of the dues is allocated for Domestic Fellows and \$106 for International/Canadian Fellows for a subscription to the Journal of Allergy and Clinical Immunology.

EAACI Members

- * Members of both the AAAAI and EAACI receive an exclusive dual-membership discount of 20% off the regular dues rate.

Membership Process

- * Once an application is received and considered complete, it will be sent to the Credentials Committee for review.
- * If an application is approved by the Credentials Committee, it is sent to the Board of Directors with a recommendation for approval.
- * Applicants will be notified within a month of the Board meeting as to the status of their application.
- * Incomplete applications will be on file for one year only.

Fellowship Categories

Fellow: Membership as a Fellow is open to individuals who have been a Full Member of the organization for a period of three (3) continuous years; and fulfill the following criteria:

- (1) Certification by a Subspecialty Board, the American Board of Allergy and Immunology or its foreign equivalent;
- (2) Continuing training and experience in the field of allergy/immunology, including regular attendance at the annual meeting of the organization or another recognized international, national, regional or state meeting of persons in such field, and ongoing practice, research or teaching in the field of allergy/immunology.

In lieu of Board Certification, the candidate must have earned a doctoral degree and fulfill at least two of the following criteria.

- (A) Recent publication of an article in a peer-reviewed journal in the field of allergy/immunology or a related field or an allied discipline which evidences original research, sound clinical investigation or advances and important discussion of the work of others in such field or discipline;
- (B) Evidence of an ongoing commitment to teaching the principles and practice of allergy/immunology to house staff, medical students or fellows in training;
- (C) Providing ongoing continuing education opportunities in the field of allergy/immunology to other health care providers through lectures, rounds, case presentations or the like.

Fellows have full membership privileges, including the right to vote, propose motions, serve on the Board of Directors and hold office.

International Fellow: Membership as an International Fellow is open to those persons who:

- (1) have been an international member of the organization for a period of three (3) continuous years; and
- (2) reside outside of the United States, its possessions or Canada but who otherwise fulfill the requirements of Fellow status as defined above.

International Fellows have full membership privileges, including the right to vote and propose motions. They are not entitled to serve on the Board of Directors or hold office.
