In the middle of the country, Mitch Grayson at Ohio State and Dave Stukus is also at Ohio State Nationwide Children's Hospital, are members of the task force. You may know that Dave also oversees the Conversations from the World of Allergy podcasts that we host as our Social Media Editor. Myself as well as Tom Fleischer, the Executive Vice President for the Academy, serve as exofficio members.
